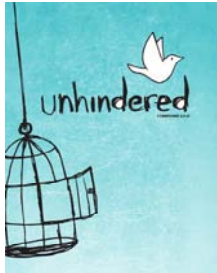


## MOPS Better Moms Make a Better World

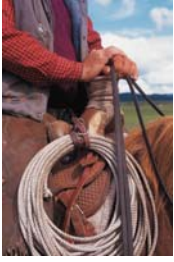
## In His Hands

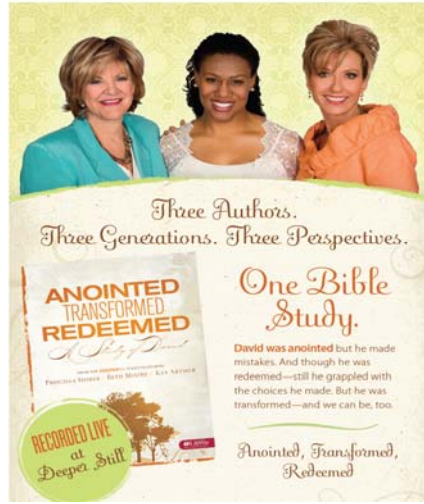
